# From the CIO's Desk

# CIO Note: September 2021 Market remained under pressure due to rising commodities and geopolitics

#### Dear Investor,


KMI-30 index decreased by 6.9% MoM while KSE-100 index dipped by 5.3% in Sep-21, as the market witnessed its worst month since Mar-20 amid downgrade from MSCI EM index and concern over external account. Overall during the 1QFY22, KMI-30 index declined by 5.6%. The month witnessed some prominent developments such as PKR touching it's all time low versus USD, continued rise in commodities prices especially coal, 25 bps rise in Policy rate and Current Account deficit of USD 1.5 bn for August.



Active cases of corona virus declined during the month in Pakistan from 93,901 at August end to 48,163 at September end, with infection ratio clocking in around 3% range. The government has administered 83 million doses till September end. NCOC has also decided that vaccination age limit for general population will be lowered to 12 years. In a widely expected outcome, the MSCI on September 07, 2021, announced its decision to downgrade Pakistan to FM status with effect during its November review, as Pakistan had a negligible weight of 2bps in MSCI EM Index. The reason for reclassification is the steady decline in market capitalization of Pakistan constituents since 2017 leading towards ineligibility on meeting the criteria in the market classification framework for EM. Meanwhile a bill was introduced in the US Senate requiring assessments and imposition of sanctions on the Taliban and persons assisting them in Afghanistan, named Pakistan also which led to concern by market participants, although it is unlikely to have any negative repercussion for Pakistan. US official have acknowledged Pakistan's positive role during negotiations and transition in Afghanistan, while US Deputy Secretary of State will be visiting Islamabad this month.

On the economic front, FBR has collected Rs.1.39 trillion (up 38% YoY) in the first quarter of the current financial year exceeding the target of Rs.1.21 trillion by Rs.186 billion. CPI numbers clocked in at 9.0% YoY in Sep-21 compared to 8.4% in Aug-21, higher than expectation. For the 1QFY22, CPI is up by 8.6% compared to 8.8% in the same period last year. With external account pressure building up due to rising current account deficit during the quarter, PKR witnessed hefty devaluation of around 3% versus USD during Sep-21, while the SBP also shifted from its accommodative monetary policy stance, in place since the advent of Covid-19, by raising policy rate by 25bps to 7.25%. The MPC noted that over the last few months the burden of adjusting to the rising current account deficit had fallen primarily on the exchange rate and it was appropriate for other adjustment tools, including interest rates, to also play their due role.

#### Commodity prices on a tear

Pakistan's import bill during 1QFY22 has risen by 65% YoY as per PBS, on the back of strong domestic demand recovery but another key reason for a such a high growth is the dramatic rise of commodities price since last one year. Supply chain disruption globally has also resulted in multifold rise in shipping index. While exports have also improved by a decent 27% YoY during 1QFY22, it is much lower compared to growth being seen in imports as the rise in cotton price is much lower compared to other commodities which are imported. Consequently, 1QFY22 trade deficit doubled YoY to USD 11.7 billion. The government has started taking measures

to discourage non-essential or luxury imports in order to curb imports quantum. The government is also engaged with IMF team for resumption of IMF program likely to conclude this month.

For the equity market, we expect positive outlook to continue on the back of robust corporate earnings growth and attractive valuations. The allure of equities over the fixed income asset class remains; this is depicted by the substantial difference between the market's earnings yield and the yield on benchmark government securities despite the recent rise in fixed income yields. Healthy participation in new listing shows that there is ample liquidity waiting on the sidelines. The market is currently trading at a low forward P/E multiple of around 5.3x compared to long term average P/E multiple of around 8.4x, along with attractive dividend yield of 6.8%, we expect the market to continue to give decent return in coming time period in line with its historical track record.

# **Stock Market Review**

During the month of September 2021, benchmark KSE-100 index went down by 2,520 points (down 5.31%) to close at 44,900 points. The average daily volume of the market stood at 414mn, up by 14% on MoM basis. Cement, Fertilizer and Oil & Gas Exploration Companies were the major negative contributors to the Index performance.

Major reasons behind the decline in the benchmark index were deteriorating macro-economic indicators (rising current account deficit), continuous PKR depreciation against USD and policy rate hike by 25 bps to 7.25%. Further, Pakistan's downgrade to frontier market from emerging market also dented investors sentiments.

Foreigners were net seller with net selling aggregating USD 44.9mn during the month while on local front Individuals, Banks and Insurance Companies were major buyer with net buying aggregating USD 29.1mn, USD 16.7mn and USD 16.3mn respectively. The oil prices increased by 7.58% during the month with Brent closing at USD 78.52/barrel.

While near term volatility cannot be ruled out, we continue to maintain a long-term positive outlook on equity market. We encourage investors to enhance their long-term exposures to the equities at these levels.


# **Money Market Review**

Inflation for September 2021 arrived at 9% YoY compared to 8.4% in August 2021. However, CPI sharply rose 2.12% MoM owing to a rise in perishable food prices. With this, the average inflation for 1QFY22 arrives at 8.58% YoY vs. 8.84% YoY in SPLY. On the monetary policy front, the State Bank of Pakistan, in its Sept'21 policy finally resumed monetary tightening by increasing the policy rate by 25bps to 7.25%.

During the month, 3M, 6M, and 12M KIBOR rates increased substantially by 41, 61 & 93bps to close at 7.78%, 8.15%, and 8.93% respectively. Post MPS, secondary market T-Bill yields also increased considerably in the range of 37 to 113 bps across all tenors. At the end of the month, 3Ms, 6Ms, and 12Ms yields closed at 7.59%, 7.99% & 8.73% respectively. A similar trend was also witnessed in PIBs, where 3, 5 and 10-year yields were up by 104bps(9.72%), 67bps(9.95%) & 55bps(10.45%) respectively. In the primary market, two T-bills and PIB floater auctions were conducted during the month. In total, Rs. 1,252 billion was accepted against a target of Rs. 1,500 billion with major acceptance in 3 & 6Ms T-bills. A Fixed-rate PIB auction was also conducted in which participation witnessed at Rs.189 billion against a target of Rs.150 billion; SBP accepted Rs.94 billion in 3, 5, 10 and 15 years tenor.

On the forex front, the PKR continued to go down against USD in the interbank and open market by another 4.27 & 6.30 rupees to close at Rs. 170.66/\$ & Rs. 173.50/\$ respectively.






#### Investment Growth from FY 1996 to Date
