
Stock Market Review

The benchmark KSE-100 index gained 2.70% or 821 points during the month of November 2014 which was mainly driven by positive developments on the economic front. The most important event during the month was the successful conclusion of IMF's fourth and fifth review which has paved way for release of USD1.1bn tranche in mid-Dec. This was followed by launch of USD1bn Sukuk that was 5x oversubscribed and prices at a 50bps lower yield than the recently launched Eurobond. These developments not only will help improve investors' confidence in the country but will also provide stability to Pakistan's external account that is already receiving a boost from declining oil prices. The Central Bank also reduced the benchmark discount rate by 50bps to 9.5%, hence, reaffirming its comfort on the macro-economic situation of the country.

Foreigners remained net buyers during the month with overall inflows of USD36.3mn making way into domestic exchange. Construction and Materials and Chemicals were amongst the best performers this month mainly propelled by lower energy prices and reduced discount rate. Banks and Oil & Gas lagged the overall market as earnings of these companies were expected to decline given the recent developments.

Going forward, we expect the market to ignore the noise in domestic politics and gain further confidence from the declining CPI which will pave possible discount rate cuts in the upcoming monetary policies.

KSE-100 Index Performance




Money Market Review

In line with the market expectations of a cut in Discount Rate via the bimonthly monetary policy, the State Bank of Pakistan went ahead to reduce the policy rate by 50bps bringing it down in the single digit range, to 9.50%. Accordingly, yields and KIBORs underwent a downward adjustment with the 3M, 6M and 12M T-bills closing 31bps, 42bps and 48bps lower at 9.59%, 9.50% and 9.50% respectively whereas 3Y, 5Y and 10 Y PIBs closed 92bps, 70bps and 70bps lower at 10.40%, 10.84% and 11.57% respective. The 3MK also closed 51bps down at 9.64% while the 6MK closed 49bps down at 9.67% compared to the previous month. Moreover the market faced a tight liquidity during the month evidenced by Rs. 343.70 billion worth of discounting availed by various counters and Rs. 777.55 billion worth of OMO injections carried out by the SBP.

The month also saw two T-bill auctions whereby in total, Rs. 504.5 billion was participated out of which Rs. 498.9 billion was accepted with major participation and acceptance in the 6 months category (Rs. 231.2 billion cumulatively at cut off yields of 9.98% and 9.49% - pre and post discount rate cut). A PIB auction was also conducted whereby Rs. 141.7 billion was accepted against participation of Rs. 154.3 billion (highest acceptance in 3 yrs category: Rs. 68.2 billion at a cut off yield of 10.90%). On the Forex front, the rupee gained value; in the interbank market it closed 103 paisas stronger at Rs. 101.90/\$ while in the open market, it closed 55 paisas stronger at Rs. 102.45/\$.




Investment Growth from FY 1996 - to Date
